5. Passport Expiration Date

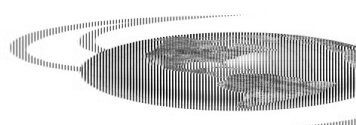

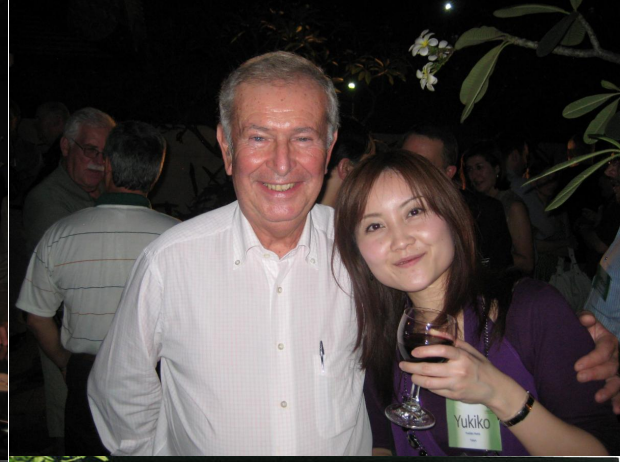
Overall, the team was already looking forward to our next Systems Review.
