Transportation

Taxi: There is no "official" taxi service for the airport, but we have been told there are usually taxis readily available at the airport.

Uber/Lyft: If you would like to set up your transportation for Uber or Lyft, you can download the app from your smart phone's app store. You will need to create your account beforehand to save time. This method is popular in big cities. If there is a shortage on taxis, this might be a good alternative.

All schedules **MUST** be finalized by **Friday, May 4, 2018**. The Scheduler will close after that and no other appointments can be made.

You will need to print a hard copy of your schedule for two reasons. One, on the right hand side of your printed OOO scheduler will be a column with a series of numbers. Each of your meeting appointments will have a number from 1-35 which will indicate the number of the table where you are scheduled to have your meeting. Without a hard copy - you will not know which table number you are supposed to be at. Please make sure you have this information. It will be important.

Two, this will help everyone make all their scheduled appointments on time. Since the OOO appointments are only 30-minutes long, it is imperative that you make your appointment on time.

A side note on making your schedules: If you signed up to attend the baseball game on Thursday (May 10) then you will need to make sure to plan your OOO meetings accordingly. Make sure your time is blocked off for that period of time on your Scheduler.
